**Key Accomplishments and Challenges**

Barberton City Schools applied for and was approved to participate in the Formative Assessment Middle School Pilot for math teachers in grades 5-8. This pilot will provide and additional \$53,000 for professional development in formative assessment strategies and allow our teachers to help create and pilot the assessments in their classrooms over the next two years.
