



2011-2012 Township Senior Snow Program Application

The 2011-2012 Township Senior Snow Program will provide snow plowing services free of charge to Township residents who – for reason of age (60 years of age and older) and/or disability – are unable to do such work, and where no other persons residing at the same address are capable of doing such work. All persons 12 years of age and older shall be presumed to be capable of doing such work. *Please note that this Program will NOT provide the frequency or level of service that you would receive from a private contractor that you hire at your own cost.* To apply, you must reside in Twinsburg Township and complete the application at Township Hall during normal business hours. Once your completed application is processed, your name will be added to the eligible applicant list. The 2011-2012 Program will begin on December 1, 2011 and end on March 31, 2012.

8. Township Senior Snow Program Rules:

(You must be able to check all boxes below).

As a participant in the 2011-2012 Township Senior Snow Program, I on behalf of my household agree to do all of the following in conjunction with the privilege of receiving Program service:

- Complete the application;
- Install and maintain reflective address numbers on house or other location on property, with numbers not less than four inches in height and visible from roadway; install and maintain reflective driveway markers along both sides of driveway, with markers at least 24 inches in height, at least 12 inches from driveway edge, and unobstructed on driveway side; and keep driveway free of vehicles and other obstacles that interfere with Program service;
- Permit Township to inspect and photograph driveway and install ID markers, once address numbers and driveway markers are in place and prior to approval and participation in Program;
- Understand that, if address numbers or driveway markers are not in place at any time during the winter season, and/or if vehicles or other obstacles that interfere with Program service are in driveway at any time during the winter season, Township will not plow driveway;
- Accept that driveway will be plowed only after a snowfall of three or more inches, and that driveway will be plowed not more than once in any 24-hour period;
- Understand that service will include a standard eight foot minimum width path, making one pass on a single-width driveway and two passes on a double-width driveway, with cleared areas extending not closer than two feet to garage doors and building walls, along with clearing snow from apron and piling snow on property if possible, away from tree lawns and sidewalks;
- Understand that Township snow removal services are prioritized to remove snow first from public roads, then from public property and parking lots, and finally from driveways under this Program, that there is no guaranteed order of driveways to be plowed under this Program, and that there is no guarantee of prompt or time-guaranteed service under this Program;
- Disclose when residency changes on property, including but not limited to when anyone moves in or out of house, as well as when house is to be vacant for a period of two weeks or more; and
- Accept that while Township will make every effort to avoid damage to property, vehicles, and obstacles, Township will not be held liable if any such damage occurs, including but not limited to driveway repairs, fertilization, planting, seeding, raking, and any other restoration costs; and
- Direct all Program concerns, complaints, and questions to Township Hall at (330) 425-4497 during normal business hours, with no direct or other contact with Service Department employees permitted.*

Violators of the above Rules will be contacted by phone or e-mail and have one week to correct the violation. Violators who do not take immediate corrective action may be removed from the Program.

**** Violators who contact drivers or other Service Department employees directly, via telephone or otherwise, or engage in threatening behavior or harassment, will be subject to immediate removal.***

WARNING

Ohio law, including but not limited to Ohio Revised Code Section 2921.13 Falsification, makes it a criminal offense to make willful false statements or misrepresentations to the public officials administering this Program. Falsification is a Misdemeanor of the First Degree punishable by up to 180 days in jail and a fine of \$1,000.
