

- Pick up and dispose properly of all litter when I see it;
- Bag and dispose properly of diseased plants and seedy or invasive weeds;
- Place old woody plants in the designated on-site brush pile;
- Place other weeds and dead plants into the designated on-site compost pile;
- Respect other plots by not picking anything from another plot without the plot user's express approval;
- Ensure that water is attended while using, and turned off after use;
- Take all hoses, tools, and other personal belongings with me when I leave;
- Keep pets out of plots and off of all pathways;
- Supervise any children that I take with me to the garden;
- Garden only between dawn and dusk, with the garden closed between dusk and dawn;
- Report any theft, vandalism, and other unusual activities that I see to a Township Sheriff's deputy;
- Remove and dispose properly of all dead plants and non-plant materials (string, wire, wood, metal, etc.) at end of season no later than Sunday, November 1, 2020, leaving a neat and tidy till-ready plot; and
- Use common courtesy, be considerate of fellow gardeners, and ENJOY!

Violators of any above of the above Policies and Procedures will be contacted by phone or e-mail and have one week to correct the violation. Violators who do not take immediate corrective action may lose their gardening privileges and their plots.
