RESOLUTION NO. 51-19

A RESOLUTION TO EXERCISE AN OPTION UNDER THE
RESIDENTIAL SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL AND RECYCLING SERVICES AGREEMENT
WITH KIMBLE RECYCLING & DISPOSAL, INC.
TO EXTEND THE TERMS THEREOF THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2021 (\$0.00)

WHEREAS, this Board on November 16, 2016 adopted Resolution No. 95-16, to approve an agreement with *Kimble Recycling & Disposal, Inc.* (“Kimble”) to provide residential solid waste disposal and recycling services for a three-year period beginning on January 1, 2017 and ending on December 31, 2019 (the “Agreement”); and

WHEREAS, the Agreement provides the Township with an option to extend the Agreement for up to two additional periods of not more than one year each, covering calendar years 2020 and 2021, respectively, on terms proposed therein and executed 120 days prior to the termination of the three-year period; and

WHEREAS, Kimble proposed terms to supplement those proposed therein, in response to subsequent governmental charges (Township Host Agreement and State Gasoline Tax), as well as significant and unpredictable changes in the cost of processing recyclable materials, in a letter dated September 11, 2019 attached hereto as Exhibit “A” (the “Extension Letter”);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Township of Twinsburg, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. Approval. This Board hereby exercises its option under the Agreement to extend the terms of the Agreement for two additional periods of one year each, covering calendar years 2020 and 2021, respectively, on terms proposed therein and including supplemental terms proposed in the Extension Letter (continuing with Bid Price Alternate 1 as initially selected), subject to final review and approval as to legal form and content by the Township attorney.

SECTION 2. Recyclable Material Processing Surcharge Continuance Determination. Kimble shall, not later than September 1, 2020, advise the Township Manager as to the then-current status of the cost of processing recyclable materials, so that this Board shall determine whether the \$0.60 recyclable material processing surcharge proposed in the Extension Letter shall be reduced in part or be eliminated in calendar year 2021. Such surcharge shall continue in full in calendar year 2021 if no action is otherwise taken by this Board before October 1, 2020.

SECTION 3. Total Compensation. Total compensation to Kimble for any services provided pursuant to this Resolution shall in no case exceed \$224,748.00 in 2020 (\$15.32 per household per month full rate; \$14.82 per household per month senior rate) and \$233,274.00 in 2021 (\$15.90 per household per month full rate; \$15.40 per household senior rate), without

additional authorization by this Board, with these amounts based on estimated households (1,225 in 2020, per actual count) and a census-based senior citizen discount (6.2% senior citizen households, per 2010 census), and with final amounts based on actual households and incorporating the same census-based senior citizen discount, as amended per the 2020 census.

SECTION 4. Meetings. This Board finds and determines that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Board and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including but not limited to Section 121.22 of the Revised Code.

SECTION 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective immediately or at the earliest date allowed by law.





RE: Extension of Residential Solid Waste and Recycling Agreement

Dear Mr. Kagler,

Kimble Recycling and Disposal is pleased to provide Twinsburg Township a response to your recent inquiry as to the extension of the residential solid waste and recycling agreement. We appreciate your business and the relationship we have built over the years working with your Township and its residents.

We are in support of extending the existing agreement based on the items noted below. The price for services in 2020 is listed in the agreement at \$14.67 per unit. As described in our covering letter which accompanied our signed agreement, we have two government fees to pass through to the Township. The first is the Twinsburg Township Collection and Disposal fee increase which results in a price increase of \$.01 per unit. The second is the State of Ohio Transportation Budget (House Bill 62) fuel tax increase. The result of the fuel tax increase is a \$.04 per unit increase in price. The price for 2020 with these fees included is \$14.72 per unit and then for 2021 with fees included it is \$15.30 per unit.

We request your consideration of another item. We have experienced significant and unpredictable increases in the cost of processing recyclable material. Through no fault of Kimble, we are losing money with the recycling program. We ask that you consider a \$.60 increase in the price per unit to cover the additional cost of maintaining an ongoing program. We want to continue our strong relationship with the Township and recognize recent bid results for similar services in nearby communities have been \$17.00 total or more per unit. We believe this is a fair compromise to address what we face in the industry.

We look forward to your decision.
