RESOLUTION NO. 08-20

A RESOLUTION DECLARING INTENT TO CONDUCT INTERNET AUCTIONS FOR THE SALE OF UNNEEDED, OBSOLETE OR UNFIT TOWNSHIP PERSONAL PROPERTY EFFECTIVE UNTIL DECEMBER 31, 2020

WHEREAS, ORC Section 505.10(D) authorizes a board of township trustees to dispose of unneeded, obsolete or unfit personal property through the use of internet auctions; and

WHEREAS, ORC 505.10 requires a board of township trustees to adopt, during each calendar year, a resolution expressing its intent to sell personal property by internet auctions;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Township of Twinsburg, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. Intent. This Board hereby intends to sell any personal property by internet auction(s), to include as specified by ORC Section 505.10 (D) motor vehicles, road machinery, equipment, tools or supplies, any of which is either unneeded, obsolete, or unfit for the use for which it was acquired.

SECTION 2. Manner of Disposal. Internet auction(s) will be conducted in such manner and under such general terms and conditions as are set forth through GovDeals. Internet auction(s) shall be conducted on a continuous basis by the Township through GovDeals on its website, [www.govdeals.com](http://www.govdeals.com), a link to which will be maintained on the Township website, [www.twinsburgtwp.com](http://www.twinsburgtwp.com).

SECTION 3. Notification. This Board shall publish, in a newspaper of general circulation in the Township, notice of its intent to sell unneeded, obsolete, or unfit for use Township personal property by internet auction(s). The notice shall include a summary of the information provided in the resolution, and shall be published at least twice. A similar notice shall also be posted continuously throughout the calendar year in a conspicuous place in the Township Administrative Offices.

SECTION 4. Items to Be Auctioned. This Board shall approve, on an individual basis, each "lot" of items, or category of items, separately, before said items are to be listed on the internet auction website. Each "lot" or category of items shall have the minimum bid price listed for Board approval.

SECTION 5. Authorization. The Township Manager, or a designee thereof, is hereby authorized and directed, on behalf of this Board, as representative for the purpose of administering the internet auction program and is hereby given the authority.

SECTION 6. Meetings. This Board finds and determines that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Board and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including but not limited to Section 121.22 of the Revised Code.

SECTION 7. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective immediately or at the earliest date allowed by law.






