This matter came on for final hearing before this Court this 25th day of May, 1967, and upon statement of counsel and a review of the pleadings and exhibits filed herein and it appearing that no objections have been filed to the creation of said water district, it is the finding of this Court and it is ordered and adjudged that the proposed water district is necessary, that it and the plan of operation of the district is conducive to the public health, safety, and convenience, and welfare and that the plan for the operation of the district is economical, feasible, fair, and reasonable, the Court, after disposing of all objections as justice and equity require, shall be its findings, entered of record, declare the district finally and completely organized and to be empowered to continue as a political subdivision.

It is the further order of this Court that the governing body of this district shall consist of nine (9) trustees to be elected by the people of the district for a term of three (3) years. The present trustees, to-wit:
