

JOURNAL ENTRY

This cause came on to be heard on this 11 day of June, 1970, on the oral application of the Twinsburg Township Water and Sewer District for approval of the procedures established for the election of a seven-member Board of Trustees and the qualification of candidates seeking election thereto, and the court being fully advised in the premises finds that on September 25, 1968, this court ordered the establishment of procedures for the election of a seven (7) member Board of Trustees and the qualifications of candidates for election as a member of such Board of Trustees in time for the general election to be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November, 1970; that pursuant thereto the Board of Trustees has complied with the court's order by adopting a resolution dated April 16, 1970, a xerox certified copy of same being hereto attached marked Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof, that notice of the passage of said resolution was given as required by Section 6119.09 Revised Code of

Ohio, that thirty (30) days has elapsed since the adoption of said resolution and that no objection thereto has been filed within such time.

IT IS THEREFORE Ordered, Adjudged and Decreed that the procedure for election and the qualification of candidates therefore, to the Board of Trustees of the Twinsburg Township Sewer and Water District as evidenced by Exhibit "A" hereto attached and made a part hereof are hereby approved and upon presentation of a certified copy of this order the Summit County Board of Elections is authorized to proceed in accordance with the provisions of said Exhibit "A", the applicable law and its rules and regulations.

CERTIFICATION

I, Louis Capazzoli, the duly elected and acting Secretary of the Board of Trustees of the Twinsburg Township Water and Sewer District do hereby certify that at a regularly called meeting of said Board, held April 16, 1970, a quorum of the members of said Board being present and voting, the attached Resolution concerning the election of members of the Board of Trustees was adopted and spread at large upon the records of the Board.

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Sewer District do hereby establish the following procedures for the election of the members of said Board.

(a) There shall be a seven-member Board of Trustees.

(b) Three members shall be elected from precinct A; three members from precinct B and one member shall be elected, at large, from the entire district.

(c) That each member shall serve for a period of four years the terms commencing on the first day of January in 1971.

(d) That the candidates shall be independent, not affiliated with any party.

(e) Nominations for the office of Board of Trustees of Twinsburg Township Water and Sewer District shall be by petition signed by at least 25 qualified electors of the precinct, or district, from which the candidate seeks office or not less than 1% of the number of the electors of said precinct, or district, who voted for governor, at the next preceding regular state election in the precinct or district, whichever is greater.

(f) No nominating petition as herein contemplated shall be accepted for filing or filed if it appears on its face to contain signatures aggregating in number more than twice the minimum aggregate

number of signatures required hereby.

Such petition shall be filed with the Summit County Board of Elections not later than 4:00 p.m. of the 90th day before the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November, which for the first election is August 5, 1970.

(g) A nominating petition may consist of one or more separate petition papers, each of which shall be substantially in the form herein prescribed. If the petition consists of more than one separate petition paper, the statement of candidacy of the candidate named need be signed by the candidate and his affidavit thereto need be subscribed by him and executed on only one of such separate petition paper but the statement of candidacy so signed, subscribed, and executed shall be copied on each other separate petition paper before the signatures of electors are placed thereon. All signatures on nominating petitions shall be written in ink or indelible pencil.

Each petition, or separate petition paper, shall contain the signature, street address or R.F.D. number, the name of the district, the ward,

if any, precinct, county and date of signing and each item of information shall be supplied or the petition shall be deemed invalid.

In all respects, except where they conflict with the conditions of this Resolution, the applicable sections of the Revised Code of Ohio shall apply to the nomination and election of candidates and all other matters affecting the validity of the petition or petition papers shall be determined by the Board of Elections of Summit County.

2. Counsel for the Board is directed to apply to the Court of Common Pleas of Summit County for an order approving the conditions herein established and, upon approval, to obtain, or prepare, such petition and petition papers for nomination as will reflect the condition of candidacy and as approved by the Summit County Board of Election.

3. This Resolution, or so much thereof as will give notice to the electors of the Sewer and Water District of the conditions for candidacy, shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the district, once each week for two consecutive weeks.
